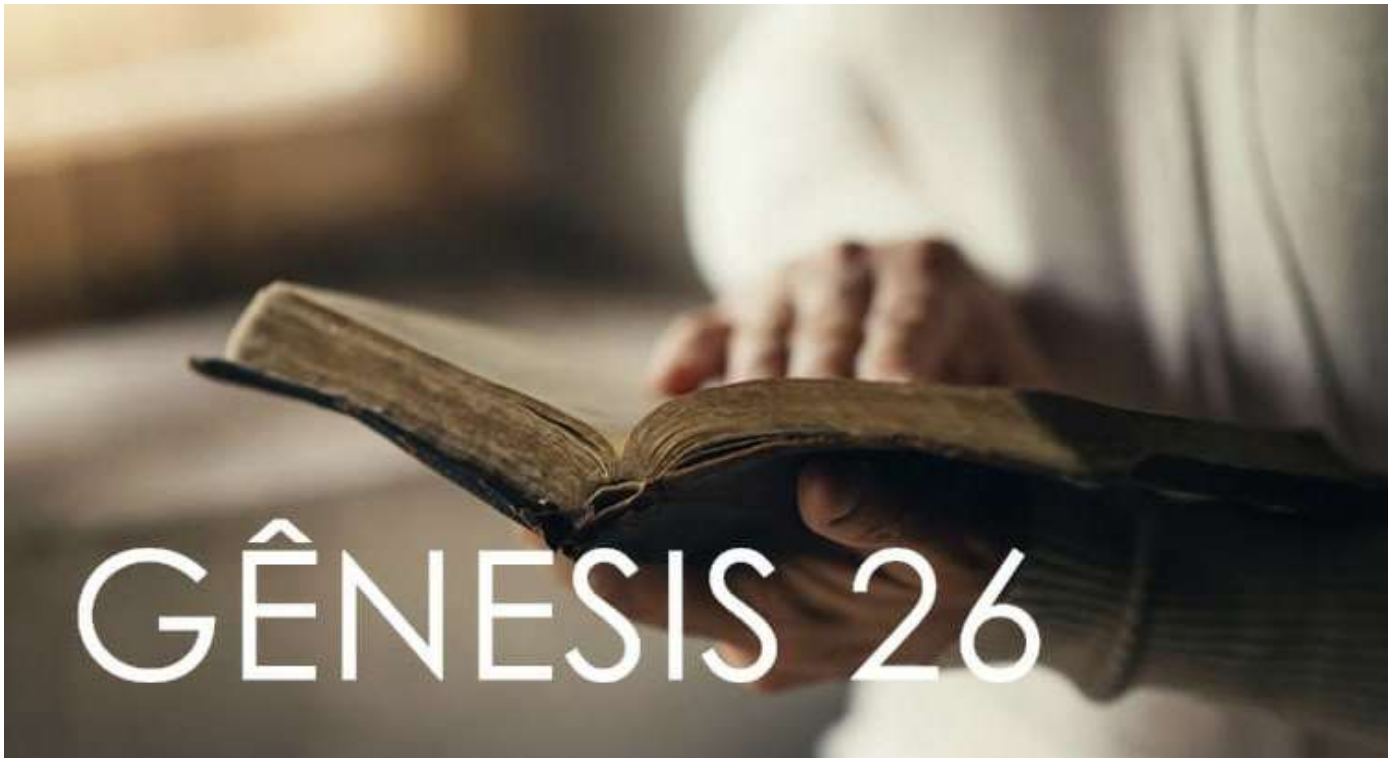

TODAY'S MUSIC: He Leadeth Me was written in 1862 by Joseph Gilmore, son of a New Hampshire governor and recent seminary graduate. Here are his words on the inspiration for this hymn:

As a young man who recently had been graduated, I was supplying for a couple of Sundays the pulpit of the First Baptist Church in Philadelphia. At the mid-week service I set out to give the people an exposition of the 23rd Psalm, which I had given before on three or four occasions, but this time I did not get further than the words "He leadeth me." Those words took hold of me as they had never done before, and I saw them in a significance and wondrous beauty of which I had never dreamed. It was the darkest hour of the Civil War. I did not refer to that fact—that is, I don't think I did—but it may subconsciously have led me to realize that God's leadership is the one significant fact in human experience, that it makes no difference how we are led, or whither we are led, so long as we are sure God is leading us.

Following the service he wrote the words to the hymn. He showed the hymn to his wife who sent it to *The Watchman and Reflector*, a paper published in Boston. Unknown to him his hymn was set to music. In 1865 he traveled to a church in Rochester, N.Y. to preach as a candidate when he discovered his own hymn in the church's hymnal. (He must have preached well; he was called to be the pastor.)
